**4:00PM** – Mayor Dalton opened the special meeting.

The Board discussed the following items for the 2018-2019 Village Budget.

### **BUDGET WORK SESSION:**

- 1. Total budget presented of \$6,506,935 (last year was \$5,990,480) if every request was included there would be a 18.97% increase in the tax rate.
- 2. Increase of \$0.154110/1,000 in the tax rate or 1.51% if every request was included it would have been an increase of \$1.94/\$1,000.
- 3. 1.98% increase in the tax levy. Under the 2% tax cap. I have provided information about the tax cap. The law states the allowable **levy growth** factor is the lesser of the inflation factor or 2%.
- 4. A \$10,000 increase or decrease in appropriations = an increase/decrease of \$.061445 in the tax rate.
- 5. Included a spreadsheet of other village tax rates for review.
- 6. 66.3% of Total assessed value is tax exempt which is up by a small amount.
- 7. Reviewed spreadsheets on how labor is allocated to different funds.
- 8. Reviewed outlines our debt payments.
- 9. Discussed shared offices including a copy of the 2018 Recreation budget and a copy of the Town budget to illustrate our expenses for the shared offices. (Code, Assessor and Recreation)
- 10. Discussion of the proposed General Fund budget.
- 11. Discussion of the Water Fund budget.
- 12. Reviewed proposed increases in water/sewer rates. We have some large projects coming up in the near future.
- 13. Reviewed the proposed Sewer Fund and Golf Course budgets.
- 14. Discussion of the Capital requests and what has been included and what was excluded.
- 15. A budget must be adopted before May 1, 2018.
- 16. New State-Mandated Cancer Benefit for Volunteer Firefighter
