DISTINGUISHING FEATURES OF THE CLASS:

An incumbent in this position performs work consisting primarily of routine patrol of the swimming area at a pool or beach. Duties are performed under direct supervision but incumbents have considerable responsibility for exercising sound judgement and rapid response in emergency situations. Performs related work as required.

TYPICAL WORK ACTIVITIES:

- Stands watch or patrols pool or beach area keeping swimmers within bounds and going to their aid when they are in difficulty
- Applies resuscitation techniques and otherwise renders first aid
- Maintains order among swimmers
- Enforces pool or beach rules
- Keeps the pool or beach free of debris and other materials hazardous to swimmers
- May perform minor cleaning or maintenance duties in the pool or swimming area
- May teach swimming lessons if certified

<u>FULL PERFORMANCE KNOWLEDGE, SKILLS, ABILITIES, AND PERSONAL CHARACTERISTICS:</u>

- Good knowledge of first aid, life saving and rescue work as applied to accidents in the water and in the swimming area
- Ability to swim well
- Ability to deal with the public and to secure cooperation without unnecessary antagonism
- Ability to keep records and make simple reports
- Good powers of observation
- Mental alertness
- Physical condition commensurate with the demands of the position

Job Details Taylor Park Lifeguard

The Village of Canton is hiring lifeguards for Taylor Park Beach for the 2020 summer season. Applicants must hold current American Red-Cross Lifeguarding/First Aid/CPR/AED and Waterfront Skills certifications to be considered. There are various lifeguard position openings including lifeguard, weekend lifeguard, and substitute lifeguard. Applicants must be available to attend a practical skills test and group interview in early June.

Description

- Responsible for ensuring safety of patrons and monitoring use of Taylor Park
- Perform opening and/or closing duties
- Supervise the swim area and beach and enforce beach and park rules
- Take appropriate action when needed to assist patrons whose safety is in jeopardy
- Provide first aid
- Manage kayak rentals
- Perform daily custodial and maintenance duties including cleaning bathrooms, raking the beach, picking up litter and debris, etc.

Required Qualifications

- Must be at least 16 years old
