PLEASE TAKE NOTICE that the Canton Village Board of Trustees will hold a special meeting on Monday, June 29, 2020 at 5:30pm, to consider and take action on a resolution authorizing the realignment of a portion of Miner Street located in the Village of Canton between Clark Street and the Miner Street bridge. The proposed realignment would reduce the existing curve in the road at or near the entrance to the Appleton Arena. The proposed resolution, and a drawing illustrating the proposed realignment, may be viewed on the Village's website.

At that time the Board will also hold a hearing to receive public comment for or against said resolution. Both the special meeting and hearing will be conducted by use of Zoom video-conference, as authorized by Governor Andrew Cuomo's Executive Order 202.1 (*extended by Executive Orders 202.14, 202.28, and 202.38*) and Executive Order 202.15 (*extended by Executive Orders 202.29 and 202.39*). The public is invited to view or listen to the special meeting and hearing, and to comment during the hearing, by any of the following means:
