## RESOLUTION Authorizing Realignment of Miner Street June 29, 2020

The following resolution is hereby adopted at a special meeting of the Board of Trustees of the Village of Canton, St. Lawrence County, New York, held on the 29<sup>th</sup> day of June 2020, to wit:

WHEREAS, on a portion of Miner Street in the Village of Canton, which lies between Clark Street and the Miner Street bridge, there exists a curve in the road at or near the entrance to the Appleton Arena. A realignment of this curve is being considered, which would help to enhance the safety of vehicular, bicycle, and pedestrian traffic in the area. The proposed realignment is described by the drawing attached hereto as Exhibit "A"; and

WHEREAS, St. Lawrence University is the owner of the property on each side of the aforesaid portion of Miner Street, and has expressed its willingness to cooperate with the Village's realignment proposal;

*NOW, THEREFORE*, it is hereby

*RESOLVED*, that the portion of Miner Street located between Clark Street and the Miner Street bridge shall be realigned to reduce the existing curve in the road in accord with the drawing attached hereto as Exhibit "A"; and it is further

*RESOLVED*, that to accommodate the aforesaid plan, the Village Mayor is authorized to accept a deed from St. Lawrence University, conveying to the Village property necessary and sufficient for location and construction of the realigned road, and in exchange to convey by deed to St. Lawrence University that portion of the existing road which, following the street's realignment, will no longer be needed for vehicular traffic. The exact descriptions of the said conveyances shall be determined by legal counsel.
