



# Halloween in Canton

To protect ourselves and one another and have a safe and happy Halloween, please follow these simple guidelines:

## IF YOU ARE TRICK OR TREATING, PLEASE:

- Trick or treat with household members only - avoid large groups.
- Maintain social distancing.
- Wear a protective mask - the CDC does not recommend a costume mask over a protective mask. It may make breathing difficult.
- Use hand-sanitizer regularly as you walk through the Village.
- **Do not go on porches or in small spaces. Anyone who wishes to pass out candy should be at the end of their driveway or sidewalk.** If no one is at the end of a driveway or sidewalk, simply go to the next one.

## IF YOU ARE PASSING OUT TREATS, PLEASE:

- Pass out candy **from the end of your driveway or sidewalk.** No one should be coming to your door.
- Maintain a safe, six-foot distance.
- Place a table or divider between you and the trick or treaters.
- **Do not** leave a bowl of treats for trick or treaters to reach into.
- Wear a mask while passing out treats.
- Wash/sanitize your hands often.
- If possible, mark your sidewalk in 6-foot spaces as a reminder about social distancing.
