- 4. How to pay for it?
 - Need \$\$ to repair/maintain what we have and develop/enhance new
 - Facilities and programs envisioned may be beyond current municipal budget capacity
 - Would taxpayers support a substantial increase?
 - Friends of Canton Recreation tap into local people, residents/taxpayers
 - Need reserve funds in budget for maintenance
 - More programming would bring more money; how to staff that increase
